

HOGSBACK WILDLIFE AREA - SHOOTING RANGE REGULATIONS

Shooting Hours – Sunrise to Sunset

Do not load your gun until you are ready to shoot

Keep your gun pointed down range at all times

Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot

Make sure downrange area is unoccupied

Shooting is allowed only from the firing line

Do not walk down range when other shooters are on the firing line

No more than two persons on the firing line at one time

Wear appropriate hearing and eye protection

Never leave an unattended gun on the firing line

Children under 15 years of age must be accompanied by an adult

Only shoot at approved targets

Never use alcohol or drugs before or during shooting

Carry out all used targets and litter

No trap shooting is allowed
